



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

STEP ONE: MOUNT FISH

1. Using a pencil, lightly mark a horizontal level line about 20" long and 50 - 55" above floor.
2. Mark 2 points on this line at exactly 16" apart (these are the mounting screw locations).
3. Install mounting screws at these 2 marked points. Note: Screw into wood/wall studs or use provided plastic wall anchors if mounting into drywall.
4. Hang fish (adjust screw depth in/out as needed to help locate key-hole slots on back of fish).

STEP TWO: MOUNT LOWER SHELF

1. At 10 - 12" from floor, mark a horizontal level line across wall about 20" long.
2. Hold lower shelf along this line, and position shelf so circle openings are exactly under rod hooks above. (We recommend using a fishing rod to help find the correct alignment).
3. While holding the shelf in this position, use a pencil to mark the center of the 2 keyhole slots.
4. Install mounting screws at the 2 marked points. Note: Screw into wood/wall studs or use provided plastic wall anchors if mounting into drywall.
5. Hang lower shelf on screws, and adjust screw depth in/out (do not over tighten).

NOTE: Fish-Shelf positions can be adjusted as needed for ceiling heights and rod lengths.
